STEP 1

- a. Tape the string to each side of the closed end of the can to create a hanger.
- b. Wrap a piece of patterned paper around the can, covering the ends of the string, and tape it in place.

STEP 2

make

- a. Ask an adult to help cut out the templates. Trace the templates on the cardstock provided and then ask an adult to help cut out the wings. You will need two of each wing shape.
- b. Use markers to create your own designs on the wings.
- c. Tape the wings to the back of the can.
- d. Fold a chenille stem in half and curl the ends to make butterfly antennae. Tape the antennae to the closed end of the can.

STEP 3

- a. Ask an adult to help cut the tissue paper into long strips.
- b. Tape the strips to the inside of the open end of the can.
