Funtastic Foosball

Introducing the ultimate DIY craft for kids: the Cereal Box Foosball Game! With the help of adults, children can transform a simple cereal box into an exciting table soccer game. Kids can unleash their inner soccer stars and enjoy endless hours of competitive play with family and friends.

STEP 1

Ask an adult to help cut out the back panel of the cereal box, leaving about a $\frac{1}{2}$ " lip around the edge. Save the back panel for Step 5.

STEP 2

- Ask an adult to help cut out a $3" \times 1\frac{1}{2}"$ wide opening on each end of the box.
- Make sure the openings are flush with the bottom edge so the ball can roll out smoothly. Now we have our goals!

STEP 3

Ask an adult to help cut out the game field template. Color it in with markers and insert it into the box.

STEP 4

- A pencil works great to poke holes in the sides of the box. Ask an adult to help punch holes $3"$ from the box ends and $1"$ from the top.
- Insert the wood dowels through the holes.

STEP 5

- You will need four players. Trace the template four times onto the leftover back panel piece from Step 1.
- Ask an adult to help cut out the players.
- Draw and color in people on one half of each player piece.

STEP 6

Fold the players in half and tape them to the wood dowels. Face the players towards the center of the field. For them to spin completely, make sure they are centered on the dowels.


You'll Need:
