Rockin' Rocket Ship

In this exciting DIY project, children will transform a Pringles® can into a captivating rocket ship! This craft allows kids to embark on intergalactic adventures while engaging in a fun and hands-on activity.

You'll Need:

- Pringles® Can
- Patterned Paper
- Two Sheets of 6"x 6" Cardstock
- Template
- Tape (not included)
- Glue (not included)
- Scissors (not included)

STEP 1

Wrap a piece of your favorite patterned paper around the can and tape it in place.

STEP 2

Next, let's make the rocket details!

Cut out the template pieces from the cardstock (2a), and trace them onto patterned paper (2b). Now cut out the shapes from the patterned paper (2c & 2d).

STEP 3

- Tape the fins to the bottom (open end) of the rocket. Keep them evenly spaced.
- Glue the windows to the rocket. Center the smaller circles over the larger circles, then glue them, one above the other, near the top (closed end) of the rocket.
- Curl the cone shape to make a point and tape the seam.
- Glue the cone to the top of the rocket.
