

Dollar General Palm Oil Sustainability Policy

Dollar General strives to promote a more sustainable and responsible palm oil industry, including transparency and traceability through the palm oil supply chain. Dollar General expects all private label suppliers to ensure that their products containing palm oil (including palm kernel oil and palm oil derivatives) are sourced in a sustainable manner and in accordance with the Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil or an equivalent industry standard.

Products supplied to Dollar General containing palm oil must be sourced from organizations that adhere to, among others, the following expectations:

- Palm oil must be sourced in a manner that supports deforestation-free production, including the protection of all natural forests.
- Palm oil must be sourced from growers who comply with all applicable laws, including those relating to fair labor practices and human rights, and the applicable provisions of the Company's Code of Conduct.
- Suppliers must not engage in activities that lead to the destruction of high-value conservation areas, natural forests, or peatlands.
- Suppliers must maintain and adhere to a "no burning" policy.

National brand suppliers, many of whom have implemented their own palm oil sustainability policies and programs, are encouraged to comply with this Policy.
